Principal's News

My messages today are reminders about our school processes, mainly for the benefit of new families to the school (we have 57 new enrolments into Kindy, (two more since the last Newsletter) and 29 new students from Pre Primary to Year 6 this year. I believe a reminder is also useful to some of our established parents/ caregivers just to reinforce our expectations (and those of other parents/ caregivers) in relation to the things we do as a community to make our school safe and welcoming to all.

After School Supervision

Young children do need to be supervised, and after school it is parents and caregivers who are responsible for that supervision. Anyone who is on site at that time will agree with me that too often the adults are chatting among themselves while the children are playing. Regularly the play gets rough or unruly, and children get hurt. This has been reported to the office on numerous occasions, and we can only respond by advising that we do not have duty of care out of school hours. I do not have an issue with parents and children enjoying the amenity of the school after hours, but please respect everyone's right to be safe.

Additionally, our teachers are extremely conscientious, and many of them continue working in their classrooms until very late in the day. The noise and ballyhoo outside Rooms 1-5 can make this extremely difficult. Please respect their right to carry out their non-face-to-face duties without interruption or distraction.

Dogs on School Grounds

Almost every entrance to the school displays **"No Dogs Allowed"** signage, and yet this request is constantly disregarded. Dog lovers, please be aware that not everyone shares your canine

affinity, and many children are afraid of dogs. If you bring your dog with you when you drop off or pick up your child/ren, please tie it up outside the gates.

Parking

There are three areas of particular concern. One is roadside parking on The Ramble, opposite the marked bays. The area is clearly marked **"No Standing 8.00am – 9.00am and 3.00pm – 4.00pm SCHOOL DAYS"**. The legal requirement is obvious. The second is people parking in disabled bays. This is unacceptable (and really disappointing) wherever it occurs. The third is picking up children from the teacher's carpark which is a very dangerous practice indeed. The entrance to the carpark is clearly signed, **"Staff Parking Only"**. Please respect this directive.

The significant majority of our school community willingly comply with these rules, and become understandably frustrated with the non-compliance of others. Let's work together as a community to make our school a happy and safe place for everyone.

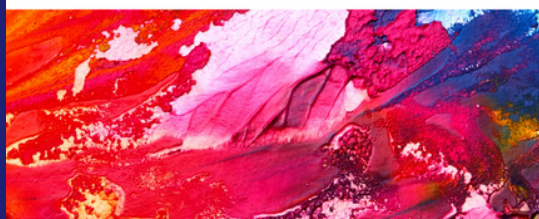
The P+C is eager to hear from anyone with ideas to help inject some colour and vibrancy into the school.
