Principal's News

Even though COVID-19 has put the brakes on many school activities over the past 3 months (it certainly feels like longer!) some of the premises upgrades have remained on the drawing board.

I'm really pleased to report that the long awaited upgrade of the multi-purpose courts is almost complete. All that's required now is the installation of the new nets and net posts, and that will occur in the coming days. This is such a boost to the school, because prior to these works it had been rather embarrassing to host other schools for the Eagles Cup netball rounds when the best we could offer was a cracked, faded court.



The Priority Maintenance Fund (State Government funded projects) will also enable us to replace the ancient carpets in Rooms 1 to 14 with carpet squares; refresh the painting in these classrooms, and repaint the external window frames on the buildings facing Clements Road.

We have a somewhat ambitious plan that may or may not come to fruition, as it would need Department of Education approval. At the moment our sports equipment is housed in one sea container, and our archived documentation in the other. We're exploring the possibility of installing a large shed, with three partitions. One would be for sports equipment, the second one an archive area, and the third a 'maker space' for teachers use to teach STEM. I'll keep you posted on this one.

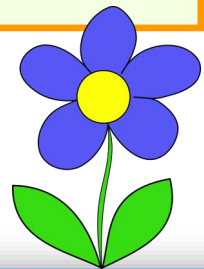

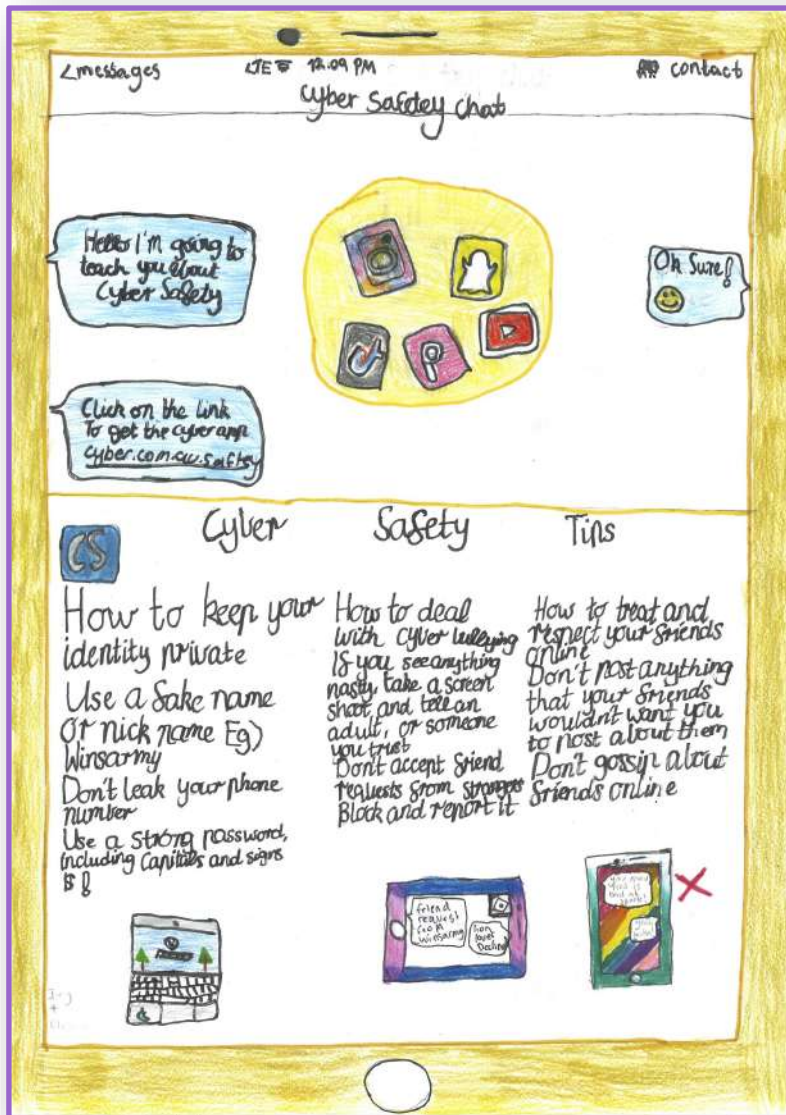
