Pre Primary's visit to Cicerellos Fremantle



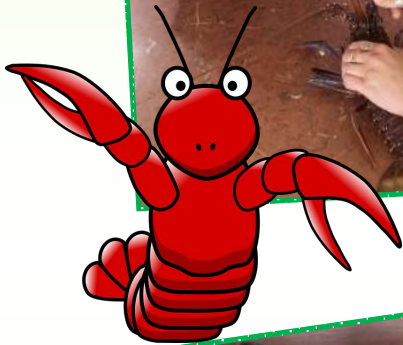
Both Pre-Primary classes had a wonderful day at Cicerellos in Fremantle on Wednesday 26th August.
