The Premier's Reading Challenge

Our magnificent Library Officer, Mrs Donabie in coordinating the Reading Challenge and we're thrilled that 82 of our students have already signed up to participate. The Challenge is a literacy engagement program established to encourage students to read more books, and to experience the joy of getting into a good book and loving the experience. By taking part and recording the books they have read, students will be in the running to win some fantastic prizes, including family holidays and experiences across WA. The activity is open to Kindergarten to Year 10, and the challenge is to log 12 or more books before 9th September.

The prizes are quite extraordinary. They include going on the Matagarup Bridge zip line, swimming with dolphins at Rockingham, riding a camel at sunset in Broome, and a helicopter ride over the open cut mine in Kalgoorlie. Not to mention diving with whale sharks and kayaking off Rottnest! There are also weekly prize draws for a range of rewards.
